Policy # 23 – Range Use By Children

RSSC welcomes and encourages young shooters to our Range. There are many opportunities for youth training.

MINORS:

- No one under the age of six (6) is allowed on the main range
- No one under the age of six (6) is allowed on the shotgun range
- Ages six (6) to seventeen (17) are considered minors

Procedure # 23 – Range Use by Children

MINOR MEMBER:

- Must be accompanied by their adult member
- No need for waiver

MINOR NON-MEMBER:

- A minor may shoot on the range with an adult other than a parent if they have a waiver signed by a PARENT
- Waiver must be completed and signed by a parent or legal guardian
- ONLY A PARENT MAY SIGN! (NOT grandparent, aunt, uncle, brother, sister, neighbor, scout leader)
- LEGAL GUARDIAN defined: “A **legal guardian** acts as the primary caretaker of a **child** or **minor**. This person may be personally selected by the **child’s** biological parents, or appointed by the **court**. **Guardianship** arrangements are necessary when a **child’s** biological parents are unable to provide care.” (<https://www.legalmatch.com/law-library/article/what-is-a-legal-guardian.html>). Legal guardianship is demonstrated by court documents
- If the PARENT is not present to sign the waiver then:
 - 1) The minor may bring a waiver that has been signed by their parent
 - 2) The parent may get the form from the RSSC website, print and sign it and Return it to RSSC via fax or scan and email.
