

## RIO SALADO SPORTSMAN'S CLUB, INC. SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2020

Rio Salado Sportsman's Club (RSSC) has established a scholarship program for the children of its members. These guidelines outline the requirements and procedures for applying for the Scholarship.

## I. Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Parents must be members of RSSC
- 2. Applicant must be accepted at an accredited college by the time the scholarship is awarded.

3. Applicant must be a senior in High School (or home-school equivalent), with all passing grades.

## II. Selection Criteria:

- A. Ranking of 1-2 page essay (topic to be determined each year by the Executive Board). Essays will be judged on content, originality, spelling, and grammar.
  [1<sup>st</sup> place 4 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place 3 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> place 2 points; 4<sup>th</sup> place 1 point]
- B. Applicant is a competitive shooter 2 points
- C. Applicant performs service projects for the Range: 2 points for each 4 hours/project (maximum points: 8 points) [Projects must be authorized and verified by the Range Manager, Lead Range Safety Officer on Duty, or Division Director]
- D. Tie scores may be broken by the applicant's G.P.A. or equivalent. The Application Review Committee may determine an alternative means of breaking any ties in case not all applicants have G.P.A.s available, or if there are ties overall.

## III. General Information:

- Amount of Scholarship – up to \$2,000 a year.

- The Board of Directors may increase or decrease this amount at its discretion. If there are no winners in a particular year the allocated scholarship funds will NOT be added to the next or any subsequent year's award.

- Scholarship criteria will be announced in January of each year in *The Ricochet* and in a BANG! email, as well as notices posted around the range. At that time the Scholarship committee will announce the topic of the essay to be written by the applicant. Deadline for submission will be April 1 of each year.

- An Application Review Committee consisting of the President and two selected Board members (or volunteers) will review the applications during April and will present the results to the Board at the April Board of Directors' Meeting. Results may not be appealed. The Secretary will notify the winner's high school of the selection so the high school may announce it at the final school assembly for that year.

- The scholarship will be awarded at the Board of Director's meeting in July. However, the award may be made prior to that if it required earlier by the winner to pay for school needs. Funds will be made out to the recipient and may be used for any college expense.
